



2017 New England Water Works Association Student and Operator Scholarship Information

The New England Water Works Association (NEWWA) Scholarship Committee expects to award the following scholarships on an annual basis to students seeking undergraduate or graduate degrees:

1. George E. Watters Memorial Scholarship (\$5,000) – Civil engineering
2. The Francis X. Crowley Scholarship (\$3,000) – Civil engineering, environmental engineering, or business management at a 4-year college or university
3. Elson T. Killam Memorial Scholarship (\$1,500) - Civil engineering or environmental engineering at a 4-year college or university
4. The Joseph Murphy Scholarship (\$1,500) – Civil engineering, environmental engineering, or a related science program or business program applicable to public water supply at an accredited college
5. The Michael Garofano Memorial Scholarship (\$1,500) – Civil engineering, environmental engineering, or a water operations or related science-program
6. NEWWA Scholarships – Additional scholarships may be awarded to students, regardless of field of study, with preference given to those candidates whose programs of study are related to the water works industry.

The NEWWA Scholarship Committee expects to award the following scholarships on an annual basis to operators:

7. Knowlton Operator's Scholarship – To operators for training when budgetary constraints eliminate the opportunity for some to attend training for certification, advancement, or professional development.
8. AWWA One Operator Scholarship (\$2,000) – To assist operators for certification/licensure, two-year community college water programs, professional training programs, books and manuals, etc. In addition, the recipient receives a complimentary year-long operator membership with AWWA.

The NEWWA reserves the right not to award any or all scholarships for any year in which outstanding candidates are not identified.

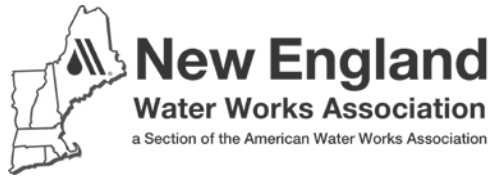
STUDENT APPLICANTS

Students who are attending or have been accepted into appropriate college/university programs at the undergraduate and graduate level are eligible to apply. Applicants must be members of NEWWA. Applicants must reside in New England or attend a college/university in New England to qualify.

Student Application Requirements

Student applicants **must** submit the following:

- Official student application form (see page 3)
- A two-page (maximum) résumé (that includes educational history)
- Official transcripts of all university education (if applicant has not started higher education, official transcript from high school is required)



- Two letters of recommendation (one must be from a teacher/professor; the second may be from a teacher/professor or professional reference such as an employer)
- A one-page (maximum) statement of educational plans and career objectives demonstrating how these plans are beneficial to water works practice in New England
- Copy of FAFSA (Free Applications for Federal Student Aid) confirmation

Selection Criteria – Students

The NEWWA Scholarship Committee considers application on the basis of merit, character and need to members and student members of the New England Water Works Association, with preference given to applicants whose programs are considered by the Scholarship Committee as beneficial to water works practice in New England.

OPERATOR APPLICANTS

Operators may apply for scholarships for training at the NEWWA facility or other institutions when budgetary constraints eliminate the opportunity to attend training for certification, advancement or professional development. Operators must be members of NEWWA.

Application Requirements – Operators

Applicants **must** submit the following:

- Official operator application form (see page 4)
- A two-page (maximum) résumé
- One letter of recommendation (preferably from a supervisor/employer)
- A one-page (maximum) statement of the need and benefit that would be obtained from a scholarship

Selection Criteria – Operators

The NEWWA Scholarship Committee considers operator applications on the basis of need and benefit to the water works industry.
