

Checklist for Recertification of Backflow Prevention Device Inspector/Tester

Check only one option below:

Recertification Criteria Requirements for an individual who hold a valid certification or the certification expired but it is not more than 6 months from the expiration date. Please provide verification of one of the following:

- Present evidence that you obtained at least 0.6 Continuing Education Units (CEU) in the area backflow prevention device testing and/or cross-connection control **and**
- You took and passed a NEWWA performance examination for recertification.

** (NY testers only --- shall provide evidence of attending a 6 hour NEWWA review training)

Recertification requirements for an individual with a certification that has expired past the 6 months expiration grace date.

- Present evidence that you attended a NEWWA Backflow Prevention Device Tester Review/Recertification Course equal to 0.6 CEUs and passed a performance examination within the past six months.
- Present evidence that you passed a NEWWA performance examination within the past six months and currently hold a valid certification issued by an organization having equivalent standards.

Fees:

- Recertification application fees are **now** included in the registration of the performance examination (practical hands-on) for recertification. Registration must be done on-line at www.newwa.org

Course fees, exam fees, and any out-standing balance with NEWWA must be paid in full before official documents will be released.

**The examination shall be taken within 6 months of the certification expiration date. Individuals testing in NY shall meet this requirement as well at attend a 6 hour NEWWA review training.
